See the QUT Guild in Action: Tour Opportunity



As part of our QLD/NT Regional Event at QUT Gardens Point on 22 June, attendees are invited to join an optional guided tour of QUT Guild services and student spaces.

This tour is an opportunity to see firsthand how the Guild supports, represents and connects students across QUT – from advocacy and welfare support, to student media, food relief, and vibrant social spaces.

The tour will include visits to:

Guild Bars - Botanic Bar and Grove Bar

Explore how the Guild's bars are being reimaged as student social and cultural hubs, supporting connection, live music, creativity, inclusivity and student value. Botanic Bar and Grove Bar play an important role in campus life, while also contributing to the Guild's long-term sustainability.

Student Advocacy and Free Legal Assistance

Hear more about the Guild's Student Assist program, which provides independent support to students navigating academic, misconduct, enrolment and welfare-related issues. In 2024–25, the advocacy team handled more than 2,000 cases, with 98% of surveyed students saying they would recommend the service to their peers.

Glass Media

Visit Glass Media, Queensland's largest student publication, and learn how it provides students, alumni and faculty with a platform to showcase creativity across print, digital, audio and social media. In 2024–25, Glass published 296 online articles, produced six print editions and reached more than 222,000 website views.

QUT Guild Food Bank

See how the Guild is responding to cost-of-living pressures through practical student support. In 2024–25, the Food Bank supported 7,490 students, a 35% increase from the previous year, highlighting the growing need for accessible food relief and welfare support.

The Regional Event will be held at the **Gardens Point Campus**, with the tour travelling to **Kelvin Grove via the free QUT shuttle bus** (which the Guild established in the 1990s!). The full tour, including travel to and from Kelvin Grove, will take **no more than two hours**.
